

Notice and Agenda of a Hearing of the Kern County Committee on School District Organization

The Kern County Committee has received a Resolution from the Governing Board of the El Tejon Unified School District to change the manner in which district trustees are elected. Currently, trustees are elected at-large. The proposal is that Board Members be elected by voters in individual trustee areas in which each trustee must reside. The Resolution also provides for a sequencing of the election of trustees to implement the change.

A Representative of the Committee will conduct a public hearing on the Committee's behalf on this proposal.

A copy of the Governing Board's Resolution and maps of the proposed trustee areas will be available for inspection at the hearing.
